Description

A refined cut-glass flower vase dating from circa 1920, elegantly formed with a generous flared rim above a tapering body. The glass has been carefully cut with decorative facets that catch and reflect the light, giving the piece a pleasing brilliance whether displayed with flowers or left empty as a decorative object.

Its flared top is especially well suited to arranging blooms, allowing stems to spread naturally while giving a fuller display of flowers. The balanced proportions and crisp cut decoration lend the vase a timeless quality, equally at home in a traditional interior or as part of a more eclectic setting.

A charming example of early 20th-century glassware, with the clarity, weight, and sparkling finish that make cut glass so enduringly appealing. It would make a lovely addition to a dining table, mantelpiece, sideboard, or dressing table, and is equally suited as a thoughtful gift.
