Description

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An elegant mid-century silver necklace and matching ear-stud set, dating to around 1950. The necklace is composed as a graceful garland of articulated foliate and floral elements, each finely set with sparkling marcasite and punctuated by luminous pearls. Its fluid, symmetrical design sits beautifully at the neckline, combining the delicacy of earlier romantic jewellery with the crisp, polished sensibility of the post-war period.

The matching ear studs repeat the necklace's floral garland motif, creating a coordinated and quietly glamorous ensemble. The cool sheen of silver provides a refined setting for the bright marcasite and soft lustre of the pearls, while the articulated construction allows the necklace to move naturally when worn.

A versatile and highly wearable example of mid-century costume jewellery, equally suited to bridal styling, evening wear, or collectors of 20th-century silver jewellery. The set retains a timeless appeal: ornate enough to make an occasion of it, yet restrained enough for modern wear.
