Description

A charming and atmospheric pair of Edwardian etched-glass pendant lamps, dating to circa 1900. Each shade is delicately decorated with etched ornament, which softly diffuses the light and gives the glass a refined, decorative character. The pair retain the elegance and craftsmanship associated with turn-of-the-century lighting, when even functional domestic fittings were made to contribute to the character of an interior.

Their pleasing scale and understated detailing make them especially versatile. Hung as a pair above a kitchen island, dining table, bedside tables, hallway console, or in a period bathroom, they would bring gentle illumination and authentic Edwardian character to both traditional and contemporary settings. The etched decoration becomes particularly effective when lit, creating a warm, subtly patterned glow.

The lamps have been sympathetically rewired for modern use with white twisted fabric flex, chosen to complement their light and elegant appearance. Both have also been PAT tested, offering reassurance that they are ready for installation by a suitably qualified electrician.

A lovely matched pair of antique pendant lights, combining original period detail with practical modern wiring. They would make a graceful addition to an Edwardian or Victorian interior, while also lending softness and history to a more contemporary home.

As with all electrical items we recommend that they are installed by a qualified electrician.
