Description

A handsome 19th-century button-back sofa, combining the robust character of an iron frame with the warmth of turned walnut legs. Reupholstered in a rich teal wool, it offers a refined balance of period form and fresh, considered colour.

The deeply buttoned back lends the sofa its distinctive Victorian silhouette, creating a softly sculptural surface that is both inviting and elegant. Beneath the upholstery, the iron framework provides unusually substantial construction, while the turned walnut front legs introduce a graceful, natural contrast. Each leg is fitted with brass and porcelain castors, allowing the sofa to be moved easily while adding a wonderful detail of original period craftsmanship.

Its new teal wool upholstery gives the piece a quietly contemporary presence without losing the generous comfort and decorative appeal of its 19th-century design. The colour works especially well with the dark walnut and warm brass, making this a versatile piece for both traditional and more eclectic interiors.

Ideal for a drawing room, library, bedroom, or entrance hall, this is a characterful and practical antique sofa with excellent scale, strong visual presence, and a beautifully refreshed finish.
