

Art Deco Platinum and Diamond Clip, Circa 1930

## Description

A very fine Art Deco platinum and diamond clip, dating to circa 1930. Exquisitely composed in the bold, geometric language of the period, this striking jewel combines brilliant-cut diamonds, substantial baguette-cut diamonds, and an exceptional central trapeze-cut diamond of flawless clarity.

The design is centred on the remarkable trapeze-cut diamond, whose crisp, angular outline provides a dramatic focal point. It is framed by precisely arranged baguette diamonds, their clean linear facets creating an elegant architectural rhythm, while brilliant-cut diamonds bring scintillation and light to the composition. The contrast between the step-cut geometry of the baguettes and the lively fire of the brilliant cuts is characteristic of the finest Art Deco jewellery.

Set in platinum, the diamonds are presented to maximum effect against the cool white metal, which gives the jewel a crisp, sophisticated appearance. The clip fitting allows the piece to be worn with versatility: at the shoulder, on a lapel, at the waist, or as an elegant accent in the hair.

A superb example of Art Deco craftsmanship, this clip has the scale, quality, and assured design associated with the most desirable jewels of the 1930s. It would be an outstanding addition to a collection of period diamond jewellery, while remaining a glamorous and highly wearable statement piece for contemporary occasions.
