Description

A fine single-strand necklace of 98 graduated natural saltwater pearls, completed by an elegant platinum and diamond clasp and dating to circa 1920. At 37 cm in length, it sits beautifully at the base of the neck, offering the poised, understated glamour associated with fine early 20th-century jewellery.

The pearls progress delicately in size from approximately 2.1 mm to 6.1 mm in diameter, creating a harmonious, softly tapering line. Their attractive cream tone and natural lustre give the necklace a warm, subtle radiance-qualities that are especially prized in natural saltwater pearls. The restrained platinum clasp, set with diamonds, provides a refined sparkle while allowing the pearls themselves to remain the focus.

Natural saltwater pearl necklaces of this quality are increasingly rare. Formed without human intervention, each pearl possesses its own individual character, and the careful graduation of this strand demonstrates the patience and connoisseurship involved in assembling such a jewel.

A timeless and versatile piece, equally suited to formal occasions, bridal wear, or a discerning jewellery collection. It combines exceptional natural material with the enduring elegance of the 1920s.
