Description

A stylish retro Amex silver bracelet watch, dating to circa 1970. With its richly textured woven bracelet and compact manual-wind watch head, this handsome piece captures the confident, jewellery-led design of the period.

The supple woven silver bracelet wraps elegantly around the wrist, creating the look and feel of a fine piece of jewellery while incorporating a discreet timepiece at its centre. Its tactile, interlaced construction gives the watch a distinctive visual depth and a flattering fluidity in wear, while the polished metal catches the light beautifully.

Powered by a manual-wind movement, it offers the pleasing daily ritual of traditional watchmaking: the movement is wound by hand through the crown, rather than relying on a battery. This mechanical feature adds both charm and collectability, reinforcing the watch's authentic period character.

The 1970s saw an especially imaginative approach to wristwatch design, with timepieces often conceived as sculptural accessories as much as practical objects. This example is a particularly appealing expression of that spirit-refined, wearable, and unmistakably of its era.

A versatile choice for everyday wear or special occasions, this watch would make a distinctive addition to a collection of vintage watches, retro jewellery, or silver accessories.
