Description

An Art Nouveau Daum Nancy cameo glass lamp with bronze mounts, circa 1910.

Sadly missing its original glass shade but then if it had this would be a £20,000 lamp.

Daum cameo lamps are exquisite examples of Art Nouveau and Art Deco glass artistry, admired for their rich colours, layered glass, and delicate acid-etched designs.

Produced by the famous French crystal studio in Nancy during the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries, these lamps often feature natural motifs such as flowers, dragonflies, landscapes, and trees. Skilled artisans created the cameo effect by layering differently coloured glass and carefully carving through the surface to reveal contrasting tones beneath.

Today, collectors value Daum Nancy cameo lamps for their craftsmanship, rarity, and luminous beauty, making them highly sought-after decorative pieces and important examples of French decorative art.
